miniSUCTF'21 Rules



- Participants can only compete individually.
- Participants must be a student of the Sabanci University.
- SU Cyber may request solutions from the participants.
- Any attempt of cheating, changing flags, moving flags, or deleting flags is a reason for disqualification.
- Any attempt of publishing solutions during the competition is a reason for disqualification.
- Any attempt of DoS/DDoS attack is a reason for disqualification.
- Any kind of attack such as DoS / DDoS, brute force, SQL Injection to the servers, the place where the event is held and the servers of the CTF competition panel, or to cooperate with the attackers or to attempt to do so are reasons of disqualification. During the competition, the network of the competition platform will be monitored against all possible attacks on traffic and a record of traffic will be kept. In an attempt of attacks or similarly security violations, SU Cyber has the right to claim all kinds of damages from the competitor who is violating the rules and to file a criminal complaint directly to the Public Prosecutor's Office in case the violation constitutes a cyber crime within the scope of the Turkish Penal Code and other relevant legislation.
- During to competition, the scores of the questions will change dynamically depending on the number of solutions.
- During the final competition, the environment will be prepared by SU Cyber to answer the questions of the competitors about CTF. Requests for assistance attempted outside this platform will not be considered.
- In terms of your security and safe, it is recommended not to use computers/data storage media with the valuable/sensitive data in the CTF competition and not to be included in the competition environment. SU Cyber is not liable to competitors and third parties for damages arising from contrary behavior.
- Although the CTF environment is secured, competitors are responsible for the security of their computers. SU Cyber is not responsible for any data loss that may occur during the competition and/or any loss or damage caused by competitors to each other.
- The degrees of the contestants that complete the competition will be official after verifying the identity information of the contestants and analyzing the cheating possibilities. Award delivery will be made after this verification process. If any cheating is detected, the contestant with the next highest score will be awarded.
- SU Cyber reserves the right to cancel the contest, change the rules of the contest, update and exclude the participant from the contest without stating a reason, in such a case, the relevant participants have no right to request anything from SU Cyber.
